

KTDB RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT

This announcement is from the Community Development Department and my name is Debbie Islam. I am here to announce the Community Data Assessment in English and Mr. Gilbert Maria will announce in Navajo.

This announcement pertains to the CDD conducting its "Demographics Assessment" which will greatly assist in the creation of a comprehensive database for the assessment of needs within our community/membership. This information will assist in the prioritization of funding considerations as well as the establishment of new funding sources. Information collected during this process will benefit many of our community programs and activities including:

- Administration
- Community Development
- Chapter Assistance
- Police/Corrections Dept.
- Economic Development
- Education
- Elderly Programs
- 911 Rural Addressing
- Employment
- Housing
- Waterline Extension
- Electrical/Solar

Some of the questions that will be asked are on Education; Employment; Child Care; Income; Type of Housing; Family Composition; Occupancy and Property Status.

Your cooperation and assistance in this effort is very important at this time, as the effectiveness of our funding applications will depend on the documentation of our community needs.

On Monday, April 3, 2017, staff from our office (Gilbert Maria, myself, Michael Eriacho, Ella Martine, Trina Martine, Gjermundson Jake) will be going out into the communities of Units 1-5; Pine Hill, Mt. View, Ramah, and Candy Kitchen and housing areas of Yucca Village, Juniper Grove, Pine Top, RNSB housing, and Sunset to conduct the assessments. We project this assessment will take at least 3 months to complete.

- Any information that is provided is confidential and that information will not lead to the identification of any individual or be disclosed in any reports or to any other party.
- Reports based on the interview will be kept in a secure storage and accessible to only the Community Development Department interviewers only.
- All Data Collected During The Demographic Assessment Will Be Maintained By The Community Development Department Personnel And Will Be Kept Confidential. All Computerized Data Will Be Accessible Only By CDD Personnel Designated With Individual "Need-To-Know" Clearance.
