This announcement is regarding the physical address of the voting members from Cibola County. Effective April 11, 2018, I received from the Cibola County Bureau of Election Office a roster list of active voting members whose address is considered as Ramah Non-Standard Street File. This roster has a list of 1,085 voting members from the Cibola County with these addresses. These voting members have to re-register with their 911 physical addresses. **Please note: You are still eligible to vote in the Primary Election on June 5, 2018,** but I am encouraging you to re-register with your change of physical address. You have until May 8, 2018, that's the closing date for the Primary Election registration.

IMPORTANT ELECTION INFORMATION FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD

**Tuesday
June 5, 2018**

In order to vote in the June 5th, 2018 Primary Election, you must be registered to vote by 5:00 pm, Tuesday, May 8, 2018 and must be registered as a Major Political Party. To register to vote, update your voter registration or to find out if you are registered or eligible to vote, please contact the Cibola County Bureau of Elections at (505) 285-2535 or visit the NM Secretary of State Website at <https://voterportal.servis.sos.state.nm.us>

Absentee Voting

To vote absentee, call the Cibola County Clerk's Office at (505) 285-2535 and request an Absentee Application. The Absentee Application must be filled out and received by the County Clerk's Office by 5:00 pm Friday, June 1, 2018. The County Clerk will begin mailing Absentee Ballots to qualified voters beginning May 8, 2018. Absentee Ballots may be mailed in or delivered in person to the County Clerk's Office. All ballots, whether mailed or delivered in person, must be received by the County Clerk's Office by 7:00 pm Tuesday, June 5, 2018.

Early In Person Voting
The County Clerk's Office will serve as the sole polling place for Early In Person Voting by machine beginning Tuesday, May 8, 2018 and ending Saturday, June 2, 2018. The County Clerk's Office is located at 700 E. Roosevelt Suite 50, Grants, NM.

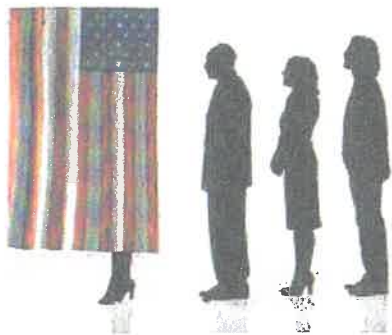

Absentee Voting and What It Means

Absentee Voting means, you will not be available on election day to cast your Ballot.

ABSENTEE BY MAIL: You can request for an Absentee Application to receive your ballot in the mail, mark you ballot and send it back by mail, or you can hand deliver it to the County clerk's office in person.

ABSENTEE IN-PERSON: You can go to the County Clerk's Office 28 days before election day and cast your Ballot on a voting machine at the County Clerk's Office.

ABSENTEE EARLY IN-PERSON: You can go to a Early Voting Site designated by the County Clerk and cast your ballot there on a voting machine.
