

# Attention!

The Ramah Navajo Chapter Natural Resource program has been given the opportunity to participate in a PZP-22 project with Sky Mountain Wild Horse Sanctuary .

PZP-22 is a long acting mare birth control that last 3 years. The purpose of this project is evaluate the formulation; improve controlled-release pellets for higher effectiveness; and to eliminate the need for a mix an emulsion .

The project requires from between 30 to 48 mares that have never received the PZP vaccine before. The horses would be administered PZP-22 formulations or PZP pellet insertion. Project will run for 4 months and would require blood draws and PZP booster.

Horses in the project will receive discounted veterinary care and feed assistance for the duration of the project.

## **How will this project benefit the Ramah Navajo Community?**

- It would provide community horse owners with birth control treatment for their mares.
- Help control the horse population growth on our grazing ranges.
- Provide low cost veterinarian services
- Temporary youth employment opportunity
